## **Consider a referral if:**

- *Your patient expresses clinically significant depression or anxiety regarding **aging issues** such as loss of a spouse, retirement, or functional decline.*
- *Your patient expresses concern about **memory loss** or possible progressive **dementia** for him/herself or a family member.*
- *You are treating a patient for anxiety or depression or chronic insomnia with **psychoactive medication** and your patient is not yet receiving concurrent psychotherapy.*
- *Your patient suffers from **chronic pain** and has not responded to medical treatment.*
- *Your patient has a **chronic disease** that may respond to lifestyle changes but has been resistant to your counseling efforts.*
- *Your patient has a chronic disease that is potentially exacerbated by **stress psychophysiology**.*
- *Your patient shows **difficulty adjusting** to the limitations of chronic disease.*
- *You feel that significant **psychological overlay** is interfering with your patient's response to your care.*
- *Your patient is **dependent** on alcohol, drugs or psychoactive medications.*
- *Your patient indicates high levels of **marital, sexual or career adjustment** concerns.*
- *You observe any other psychological concern of while treating your patients.*
